

CARGO SEALS

Cargo security seals are used to secure a variety of containers.

All of our mechanical security seals include pre-assigned unique serial numbers. Some seals include matching bar codes. We offer barrier seals, bolt seals, cable seals, plastic adjustable bands, and more.



Plastic Seals

NovaVision offers various plastic seals which are used to mechanically secure a variety of containers. Typical applications include truck doors, trailer doors, railcar doors, totes, valves, coin bags, inner drum bags, crime scene evidence storage bags, and any container with a hasp or loops.

We offer adjustable and non-adjustable plastic seals.

Cable Security Seals

Cable seals are durable and intended for higher security applications. They are available in different cable diameters and lengths for use in various applications.

Our 3.5mm and 5.0mm cable seals are compliant with ISO 17712:2013 and are rated as a high security (H) seals. Authentic NovaVision cable seals have our brand name NovaVision™ etched on the locking housing.

Bolt Security Seals

Bolt security seals are very durable and intended for high security applications. Both the bolt and lock have matching serial numbers, which are laser etched into the plastic covering.

The bolt is inserted into the locking mechanism, where the metal bolt snaps into place within the metal locking cylinder. The metal bolt and metal locking cylinder are encased in plastic, which is designed to show signs of tampering. If attacked with a heat source, the plastic will discolor and/or melt.

Barrier Seals

Barrier seals provide the maximum protection for shipping cargo via trucks and containers. Installed on the locking rods of the shipping container doors to secure both doors, they are easy to install and require no special tools.

Pallet Seals

Thieves can easily access pallets with conventional banding and remove and replace that generic banding and metal crimps with little skill or effort. After the banding is removed, the contents can be removed and/or contraband can be added. Then new strapping and/or metal crimps are applied to replace the original strapping and crimps. We offer three pallet seal systems to combat pallet tampering and pilferage.
